### Rock Classification.

**Reference**:-Internet

There are three basic rock groups:-

Metamorphic: Means change in form and sedimentary or igneous rocks can be changed into metamorphic rocks by heat, pressure or through chemical action. As a result of this often new minerals are formed.

Sedimentary:- This rock is formed when mineral or organic matter settles and accumulates from a solution. This rock forms a very small amount of the earth's crust Forming in layers as strata this rock gives a lot of information about the history of the earth and of life. Sources from this strata are a great variety of fossils, minerals, coal and water.

Igneouss: Those are called 'fire rocks' as they are formed from magma beneath the earth's crust and become igneous rocks when they cool. They are also formed from the lava from volcanoes, as it cools above ground. An example of igneous rock is porphyry.
