BLUE JOHN.

Blue John is calcium fluorite which has distinctive blue- purple with yellow banding. It is coloured by oil deposited on the crystals millions of years ago. In Britain it is found in Derbyshire near the town of Castleton at a hill known as Treak Hill, or locally as the Devils Arse.

There are four large caverns within the hill. The largest of these has been used for different venues including a rope works, concerts and fireworks displays. These caves have been tourist attractions since the 1100s, when King Henry 11 included it on a grand tour. Rope making is still demonstrated here beside the subterranean village built into the walls of the cave where workers lived. One of the caverns shows a unique selection of machinery and tools used by the miners.

The cave temperature stays at a constant 45'. During heavy rains the caves can flood at a rate of 5" per minute. Boat trips have sometimes been arranged when the caves are flooded.

This area is the only known source of Blue John in the world. Earlier caverns were discovered around 1745. These became the first Blue John Mines. By 1870 this material was going out of fashion but after the first World War there was a demand

for fluorspar for flux, for use in blast furnaces in Sheffield.

In 1926 an amazing discovery was made when blasting in the area opened up a magnificent cave full of multicoloured stalagtites and stalagmites. This is one of Britain's most spectacular caverns. It was opened to the public in 1935.

Blue John is still mined in the caverns in winter and beautiful jewelry and small ornaments are made for the shops in Castleton to sell to tourists.


A recent find was made in China of fluorite very similar to Blue John.

Two of our long time members John & Irene Phillips visited Castleton and the mines here a few years ago and had a very enjoyable trip.


